Test-Day Details:

First Day Arrival-Time and Drop-Off Details

Please make sure your child **arrives fifteen minutes early on their first day of testing** and **bring them into the Karis Church Activities Building**. Please be sure to come into the Activities Building, yourself, on your student's first day of testing to self-address an envelope that we will use later to send you your child's scores. You should receive these sometime in late May.

On Tuesday, if your child is in 2nd, 3rd, or 4th grade, after registering in the Activities Building, you will be asked to accompany your student to his or her testing room and remain with your student for the first fifteen minutes. We'll depend on your assistance to get your child settled and comfortable, and we expect they will need your help entering their name, address, and birth date in their testing booklet by filling in the coordinating circles.

Testing Day Structure

Students will take subject-specific tests (Math, Language, History, etc.) during each morning, and will therefore also experience breaks throughout the morning, between each testing period, when they will be able to eat a snack, use the restroom, get up and stretch, etc.

What to Bring

- Three sharpened #2 pencils
- Ruler
- Snack
- Drink
- Book to read each day in case he/she finishes early.

Pick-Up

Students should be picked up from inside the Karis Church Activities Building. Please come inside and notify your student's proctor when you are leaving with your student.

If you have several children taking the test, they will likely finish at different times. Since it will be difficult for us to manage students who finish testing early and are released from their test rooms, please arrive 10 minutes early at the Activities Building to be on hand in case your student is released early.

Dress Code

Students are asked to wear modest, clean-cut clothing.

Shorts will be permitted, but please, no shorts shorter than three inches above the knee.

Blue jeans that do not have rips or holes and are not excessively tight will also be acceptable.
