Study Halls: Study halls are provided for students who plan to remain on campus when courses are occurring yet are not enrolled in a course for that hour. Study hall is intended for students' private and individual study or progress in coursework.

Rosetta Stone Language Acquisition Program: Rosetta Stone Courses at Heritage include 82 lessons per semester plus extra work in four areas: 1) vocabulary, 2) translation work, 3) conjugation charts, and 4) cultural appreciation projects. Students in 8-12th grades have the opportunity to learn any of 24 languages using Rosetta Stone Foundations web-based software.

Student Success Center: The SSC currently runs on T/TH from 1-3 PM.

Electives: Some electives such as ACT prep, Servant-Leader Program, or the Rosetta Stone Language Acquisition Program may run on a T/TH schedule. Refer to the family manual for high school graduation requirements for electives.

Athletics: Seventh through twelfth grade students may also register to participate in seasonal competitive sports.
